



Terms and conditions for applying

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Each application for an "It's Our Community" award ("Award") must be consistent with the aims of the It's Our Community scheme. Projects must be a not for profit activity. Projects must involve a tangible improvement aimed at inspiring the community.

Only projects that take place within the Isle of Man are eligible for an Award. The following projects are not eligible for an Award:

- projects which benefit only individuals or are on private land;
- projects aimed at raising money for third party giving organisations;
- school projects which do not benefit the whole community; or
- community fêtes, festivals or any other events.

Applicants under 18 years of age must have the written consent of a parent or guardian, or an endorsement from a charity or recognised community organisation.

It's Our Community assessors may either visit your project or interview you by telephone. You must be willing to take part in this process and where appropriate make your project available for a visit by an assessor at a time mutually agreed by you and the assessor.

Multiple applications are permitted provided that they relate to substantially different projects. If your application is unsuccessful, you may reapply six months after your initial application in respect of the same project. If you have applied in respect of a number of different community projects, the status of one has no affect on the other(s). If your application is successful then you can apply for a further award in respect of the same project after 12 months.

Manx Telecom Ltd aims to advise applicants within 28 working days of whether or not an application for an Award has been successful.

Successful applications will receive an Award of between £100 and £1000. The actual Award may differ from the sum applied for. Any part of the Award that is unused once the project is completed must be returned. The Award is not designed to provide top-up funding for larger projects.

Successful applicants who have already received an Award can reapply for additional awards using the usual application procedure, but only once twelve months have elapsed from the previous award.



We would like to publicise all your It's Our Community projects. As a result of this, all applicants are required to submit a photo of the project (either before or after).

Awards are granted on the basis of the original application. If a project changes scope, any proposed changes must be approved by the It's Our Community team.

If Manx Telecom Ltd believes that any funds which have been provided are being misused in any way, or that the project is not being run as a not-for-profit project then Manx Telecom Ltd reserves the right to suspend further funding of the project pending investigation of the nature of the project.

If, at any time Manx Telecom Ltd considers that it is no longer appropriate to provide funding to a particular project, for any reason, Manx Telecom Ltd reserves the right to discontinue funding for the project.

Manx Telecom Ltd accepts no responsibility for applications that are lost, delayed, misdirected, and incomplete or cannot be delivered or entered for any technical or other reason.

Manx Telecom Ltd accepts no responsibility for any damage, loss, liabilities, injury or disappointment incurred or suffered by you as a result of submitting an application or accepting an Award.

The assessors' decision on all matters relating to It's Our Community scheme and its administration will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
