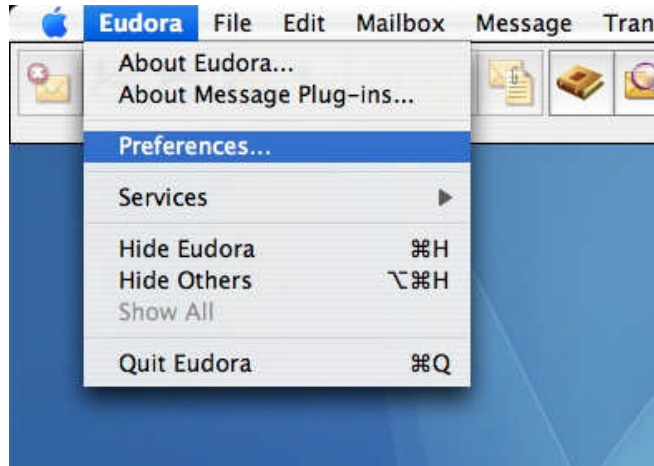


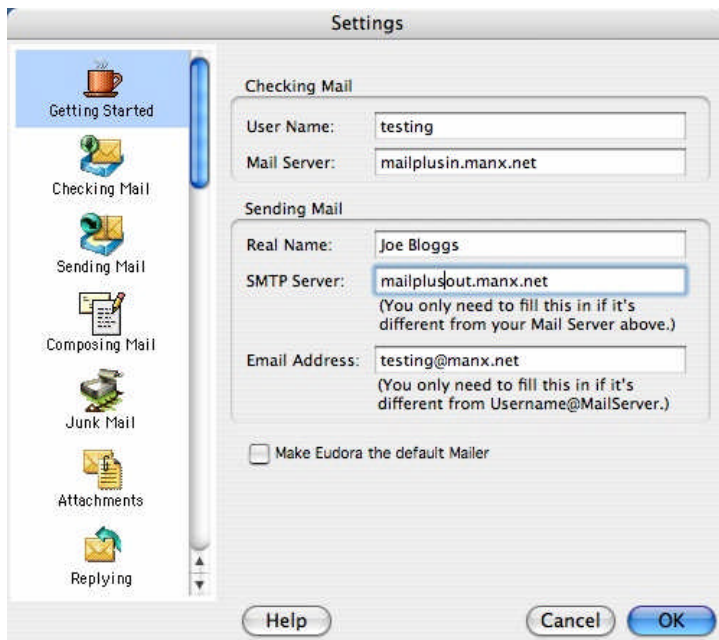
Setting up Eudora for Manxnet Mail Plus

This procedure will assist you in setting up Eudora for your Manxnet Mail account.

- Open the Eudora program



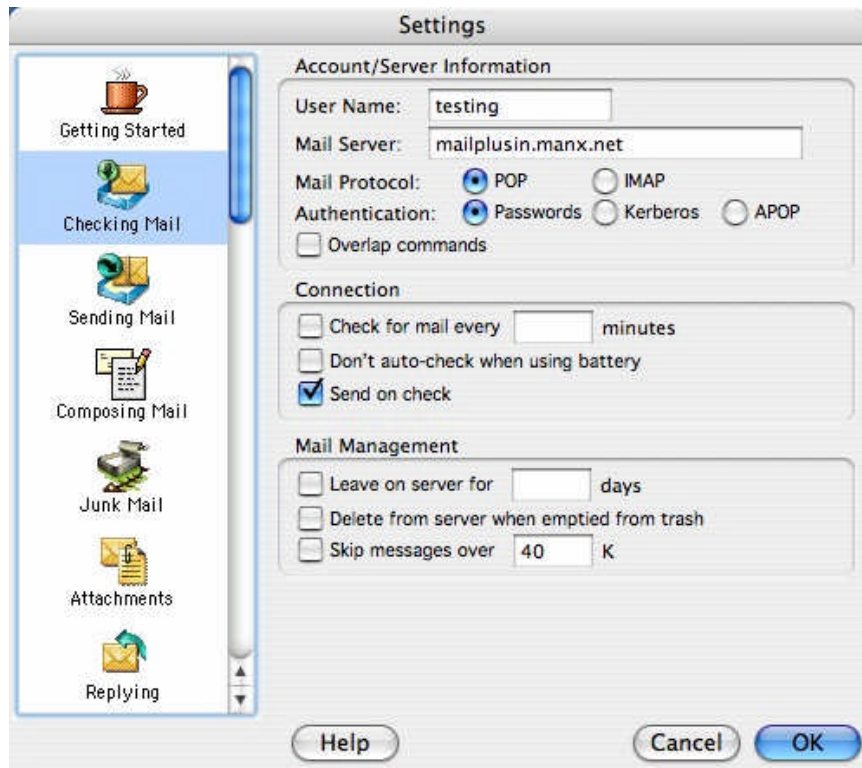
- Click **Eudora** and select **Preferences**



In the **Getting Started** screen fill out your details as follows:

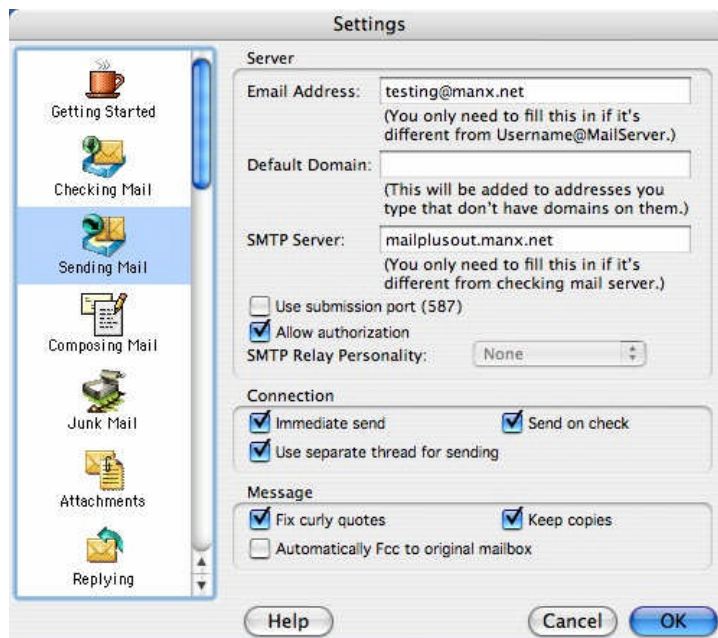
- **Username:** Enter the first part of your e-mail address without the @manx.net, in our example the e-mail address is testing@manx.net so the Username is **testing**
- **Mail Server:** This is the incoming Mail Server so enter **mailplusin.manx.net**
- **Real Name:** Enter your name as you would like it to appear when you send an e-mail to someone
- **SMTP Server:** **mailplusout.manx.net**
- **Email Address:** Enter your e-mail address here, in our example the e-mail address is testing@manx.net

Once you have filled out the details click **Checking Mail**



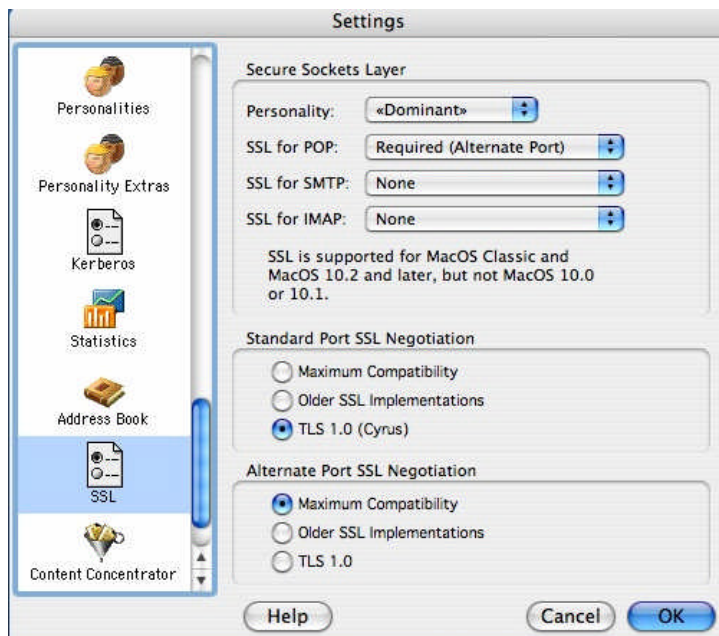
In the **Account/Server Information** screen fill out the details as follows:

- **User Name:** Enter your e-mail Username here: the first part of your e-mail address without the @manx.net
- **Mail Server:** This is the incoming Mail Server, this should be: **mailplusin.manx.net**
- **Mail Protocol:** POP
- **Authentication:** Passwords



In the **Server Settings** screen fill in the details as follows:

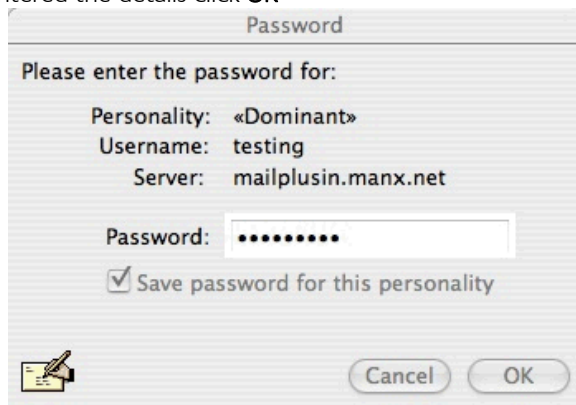
- **E-Mail Address:** Enter your e-mail address here
- **Default Domain:** Leave this blank
- **SMTP Server:** This is the outgoing Mail Server, this should be: **mailplusout.manx.net**



On the left-hand side of the **Settings** window, scroll down till you see **SSL** link. Click this link and fill this out as above:

- **Personality** – Dominant
- **SSL for POP** – Required (Alternate Port)
- **SSL for SMTP** – None
- **SSL for IMAP** - None

Once you have entered the details click **OK**



Click the **Check Mail** icon and you will be prompted for the password as above; enter your e-mail password and if you wish, tick the box **Save password for this personality**
