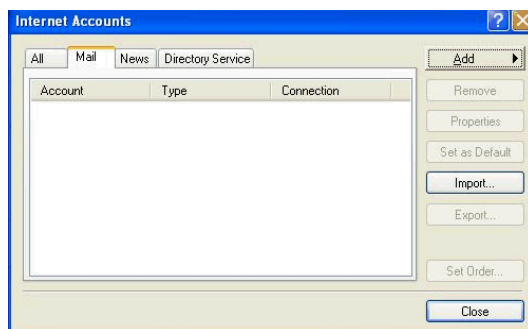


Setting up Outlook Express for Manxnet Mail Plus

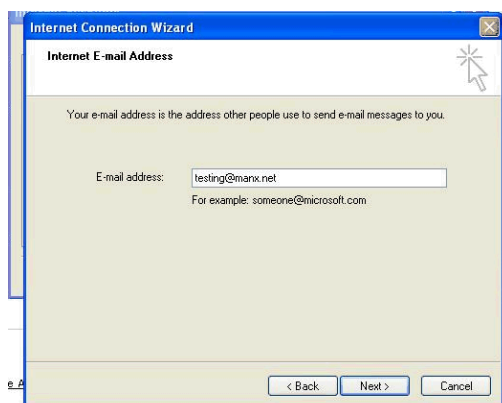
- Open your Outlook Express program by clicking the **Start** button and selecting Outlook Express from the program list or double-clicking the icon on your desktop.



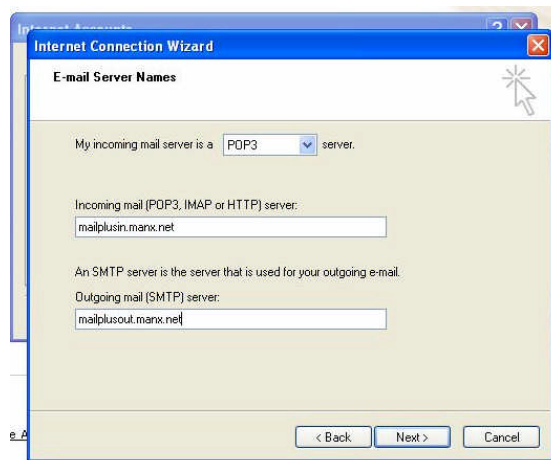
- Once the program is open click **Tools** and select **Accounts**. This will open the above **Internet Accounts** window. Click the **Mail** Tab
- Click the **Add** button and select the **Mail** option



- In the **Display Name** field type your name as you would like it to appear when you send an e-mail and click **Next**.



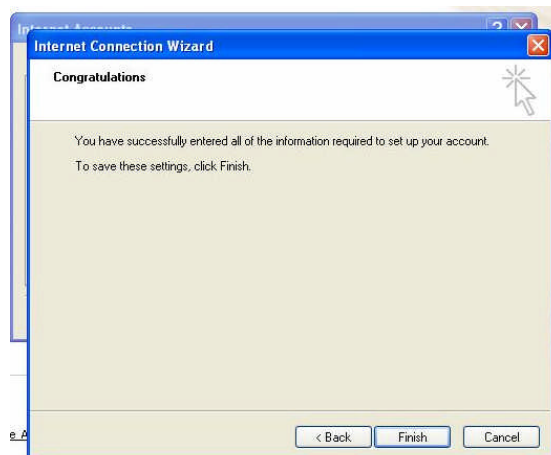
- Enter your Manxnet **e-mail address** and click **Next**



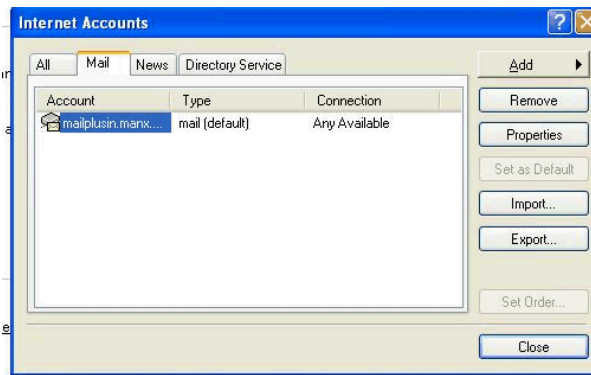
- In the **E-mail Server Names** screen complete the details as follows:
- My incoming mail server is a **POP3** server
- Incoming mail (POP3, IMAP or HTTP) server: **mailplusin.manx.net**
- Outgoing mail (SMTP) server: **mailplusout.manx.net**
- Click **Next**.



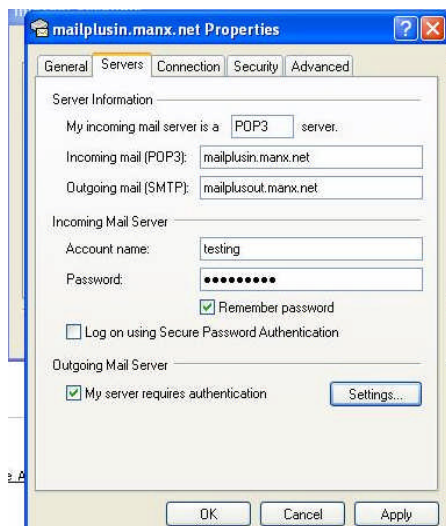
- Your **Account Name** should already be entered. The Account Name is the first part of your e-mail address without the @manx.net. As the e-mail address we are using in this tutorial is testing@manx.net the username is testing. Enter your e-mail password and tick the box **Remember password**.



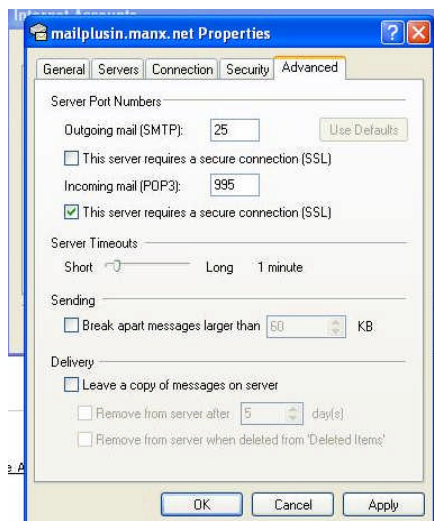
- Click **Finish** create your Manxnet Mail Plus account in Outlook Express.



- Your new account is now in the **Internet Accounts** window. Click your account to highlight it and then click **Properties**.



- When the **Properties** window is open click the **Servers** tab and tick the box **My server requires authentication**, then click the **Advanced** tab.



- In the **Advanced** window, under **Incoming Mail** tick the box **This server requires a secure connection (SSL)** and click **OK**. Close the **Internet Accounts** screen. You can now start to send and receive e-mails.
